JOB DESCRIPTION

Position Title: Pavement Marking Laborer

Reports To: Pavement Marking Lead Person/"Foreman"

Position Summary: Installs paint, epoxy, and poly preform roadway pavement markings, such as long-lines, arrows, crosswalks and other various symbols and markings.

Responsibilities:

- Assist in installation of pavement markings.
- Operation and preventative maintenance of pavement marking vehicles/equipment.
- Assists in maintenance and general housekeeping of striping shop.
- Works under the direction of Striping Lead Person aka "foreman".
- Utilizes necessary hand and power tools in accordance with proper safety procedures.
- Records various paperwork such as time card, vehicle inspection reports, daily striper logs.
- Receives on-site training from foreman and classroom instruction from safety officer.
- Sets up and maintains adequate traffic control measures to protect markings.
- Professional and cordial with common public and customers.
- Other duties as assigned.

Working Conditions:

- Primarily outdoor work with exposure to dust debris, strong fumes.
- Subject to working in a variety of extreme weather conditions.
- Subject to extreme noise levels when operating certain equipment.
- May occasionally work in confined or cramped spaces.
- Exposure to mechanical, electrical, and chemical hazards associated with pavement marking equipment as well as working in and around moving traffic.

Travel:

- May on occasion be required to work out of town for unspecified lengths of duration and must be prepared with adequate clothing and personal necessities.

Requirements:

- High School Diploma or G.E.D.
- Current Minnesota Class D driver's license.
- Must be able to obtain and become certified, if required with various certifications such as but not limited to 3M tape installers certification, Forklift operators certification, Flagger certification, and CPR/1st. aid certifications.
- Punctual and accountable.
- Able to follow written and oral instructions.

Preferred Requirements:

- Any combination of education, training, and experience providing the following knowledge, skills, and abilities: Basic mechanical aptitude, general construction knowledge, familiarity with general pavement markings and/or traffic control, and ability to read and understand a road map or general ability to find work sites located throughout the states of Minnesota/Wisconsin. Current Minnesota Class B commercial driver's license.
